Joyaux, ACFRE is an internationally recognized consultant, speaker, and author of two groundbreaking books, Strategic Fund Development: Building Profitable Relationships That Last, and Keep Your Donors (with Tom Ahern). She is the recipient of the 2003 Rhode Island Outstanding Philanthropic Citizen Award and the 1987 Fundraising Executive of the Year Award for Rhode Island. With more than 25 years of professional philanthropy experience, Joyaux has served as a chief development officer, executive director, and board chair.

Simone's firm, Joyaux Associates, provides fundraising and organizational development services to foundations, major institutions, government agencies, and grassroots organizations. She is a faculty member for the Masters Program in Philanthropy and Fund Development at St. Mary's University, Minnesota and is frequently called upon to develop and deliver workshops, seminars, keynote addresses, and comprehensive curricula for philanthropy professionals in a variety of venues, including: Bryant College ((Nonprofit Management Certificate Program), Association of Fundraising Professionals, Alliance for Children and Families, St. Mary's University Masters Program in Philanthropy and Development, and numerous community foundations.

Simone has served as Chair of CFRE International, the baseline certification program for fundraisers worldwide. During her tenure, the program achieved its independence and established itself internationally.
